## **General Information**

#### **Organisation**

- 1) The promoter for this event is Mr Kevin Pickering.
- 2) The gala will be held under Swim England's Laws & technical rules.
- 3) Swimmer registration will end at the commencement of the warmup period. All swimmers not registered at this time will be withdrawn from the gala.
- 4) The one start rule will apply.
- 5) Over the top starts may be used at the referee's discretion.
- 6) Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool.
- 7) Swimmers must start in the water unless they hold the current and relevant competitive start award.
- 8) Integrated mixed heats will be swam i.e. swimmers race according to ability rather than gender.
- 9) Heats will be seeded on PB times or on the advice of Chief Coach.
- 10) The pool is 25m long, 6 lanes with anti wave lane ropes.
- 11) No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside. Footwear must be worn outside the pool area.
- 12) Age Groups are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, and 15yrs & over.

- 13) 25mt events restricted to 12yrs and under.
- 14) Ages are as at 31st December 2024.
- 15) Entries will only be accepted from member clubs of Hull & District Swimming Association.
- 16) Entry will be restricted to county level swimmers and lower (no regional level swimmers or above will be permitted to enter this meet)
- 17) Poolside entries will not normally be accepted, however in exceptional circumstances may be accepted at the discretion of the promoter.
- 18) All entry withdrawals must be presented to the recorder before the start of the relevant warm-up of each session.
- 19) Coaches and Team Managers are requested to ensure their swimmers respect the officials and are silent at the start of each heat. Team Managers or Coaches must supervise the warm up of their swimmers.
- 20) The Referees decision is final.
- 21) Entry fee of £3.00 per event.
- 22) The use of Video and Photography is restricted at all Galas. If you wish to use such equipment at this Gala you must register your name and address with the door steward. This includes mobile phones with camera or video facilities.
- 23) The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 24) Any point not covered by these rules will be at the discretion of the organisers and the promoter.

#### **Awards**

Awards will be presented from 1st place to 6th place finishers in all age groups

- 1. All entries are £3.00 per individual event.
- 2. Entries will be accepted electronically via sports systems entry file
- 3. Entry closing date 25th February 2024
- 4. Payment of entry fees ONLY by BACS
